Pediatric primary care services available include physical health care, mental health care, and enrollment in Medicaid and CHP+, and support accessing other resources to meet immediate needs.

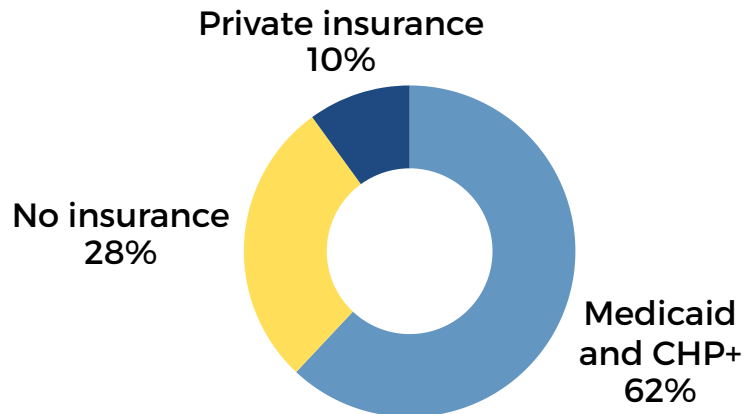

SUCCESS STORY

During a visit at one of Kids First Health Care's community clinics, an overwhelmed mother of twins came in for her toddlers' well-child checks.

Their developmental screeners came back positive for developmental delays. During their appointment, the health educator and provider assessed both children, and they were identified as possibly having autism.

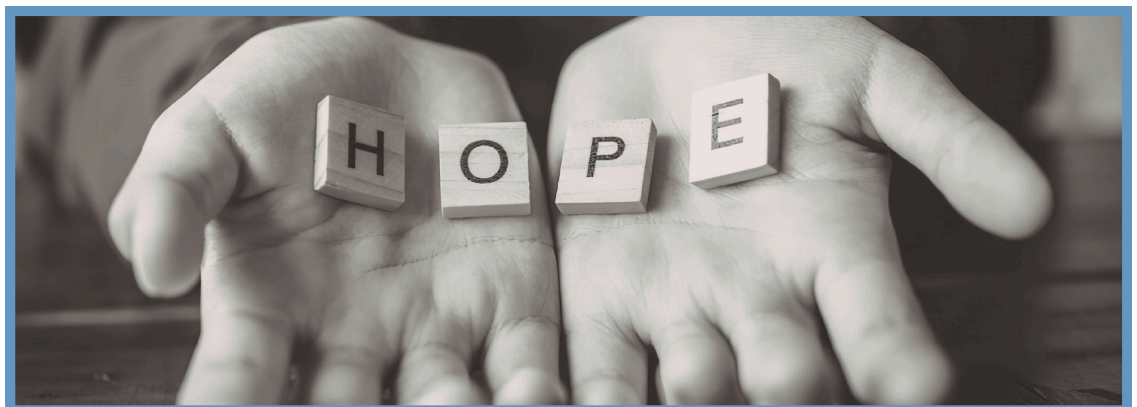
As a result, the provider referred them to our medical director to perform an official autism assessment. After the medical director met with both twins, she was able to diagnose them with autism.

This diagnosis was a shock for their mom, and was understandably distraught and overwhelmed. The Kids First Health Care behavioral health provider met with her, and was able to refer her to mental health services for parents, as well as to a parenting course for autism.

The Kids First Health Care clinic team supported this mom with this diagnosis and encouraged her with next steps, including referring the patients to a center that works with the patients on applied behavior analysis (ABA), speech and occupational therapy.

The family returns regularly for check-in appointments, and have made significant progress. The mother has expressed her appreciation for the care provided by our clinic team, and for encouraging and supporting her through this new diagnosis.

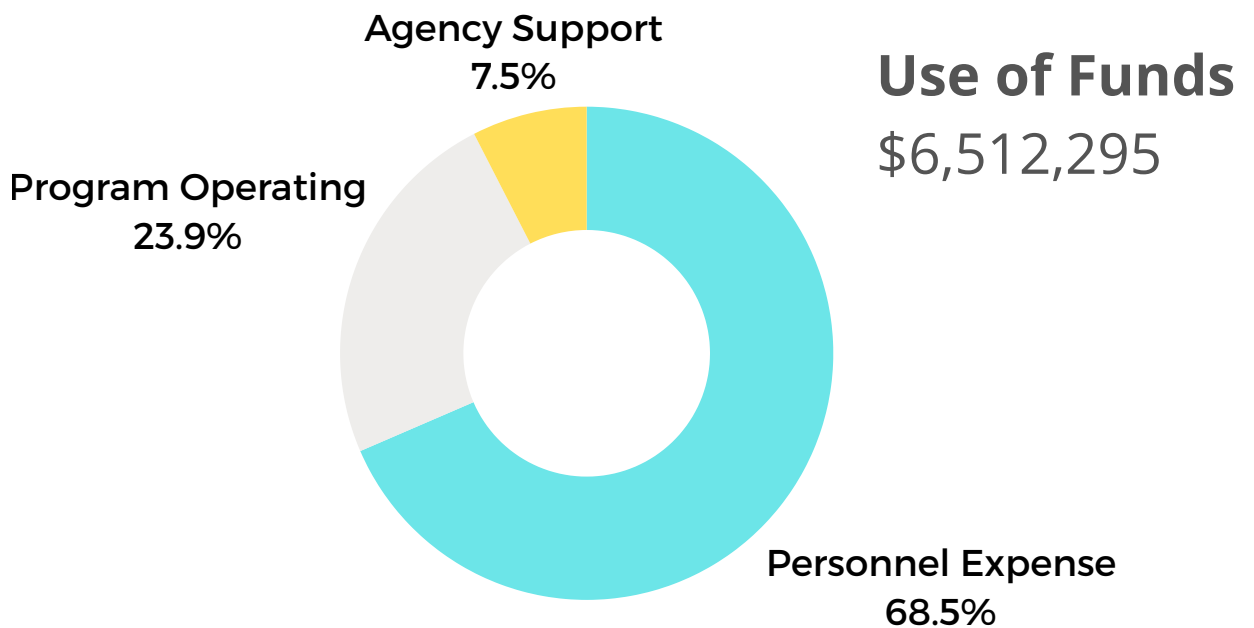
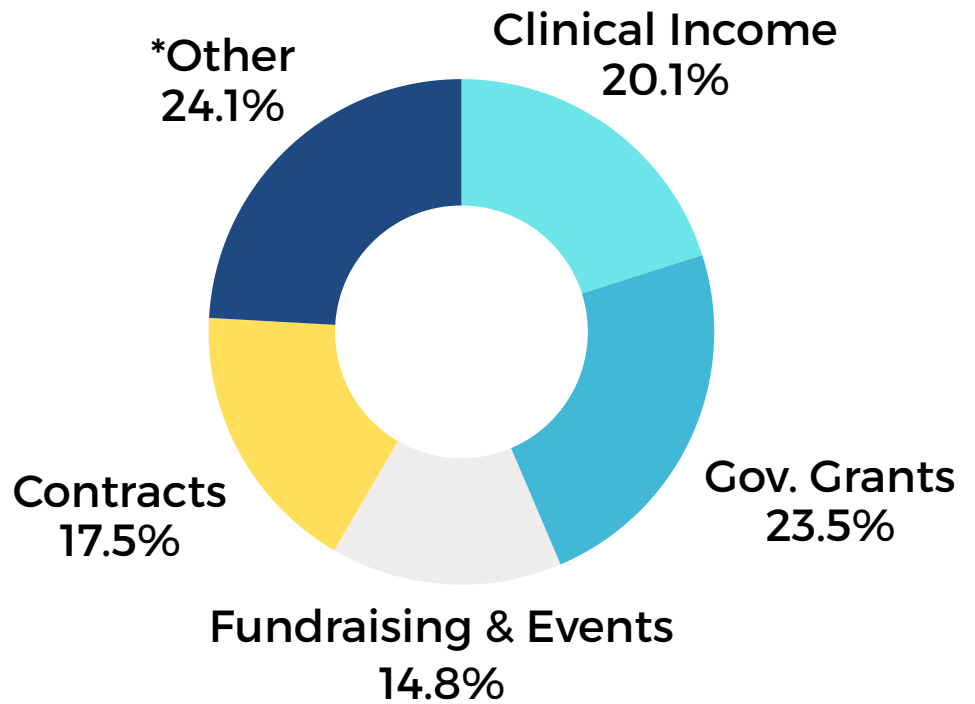

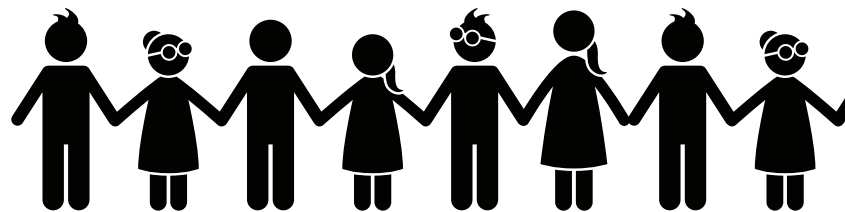
